FGV is a not-for-profit, unlisted public company which means we work for our members.

FGV is controlled by its Board of Directors whose role is to provide good governance, determine policy and provide direction to the Operations Committee. Board Directors are elected by FGV members annually for 3 year terms with staggered retirement by rotation. Retiring directors may renominate.

The day-to-day running of the business is managed by our Operations Committee, appointed by the Board who adhere to the direction and policies in accordance to the vision of the Board.
