## Around the Orchards



Agronomic Advice
Aphid - over the last 4-5 years seeing an increase of populations where excess insecticides are used. Monitor and only spray if no parasitism seen.

Thrips - monitor daily during warm spells, try to avoid using synthetic pyrethroids where possible.

LBAM - always look for a second peak of moth numbers prior to setting a biofix. Egg hatch predicted for 22-23 September (GV). Bt's (Dipel) best control this time of year and do not disrupt IPM.
